[F] I write I'm sorry but my letter keeps coming [G] back

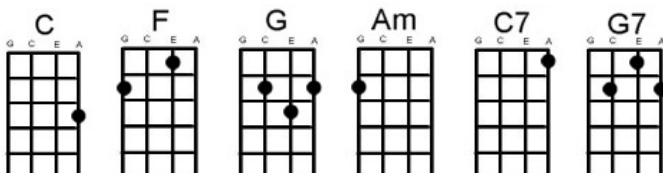
[C] So then I dropped it in the [Am] mail box
