[G] Dreams come true, [C] in Blue Ha[G]waii /// [E7]

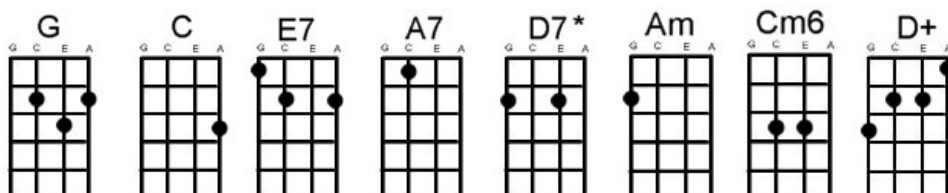
