BRIDGE:

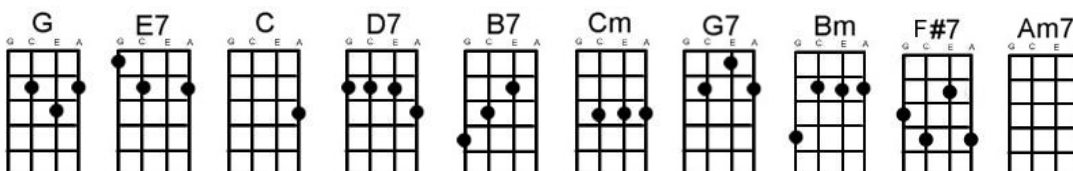
[Am7] Knee deep in [Bm] flowers we'll [E7] stray
