[Dm7] Her powder all [G7] over my vest

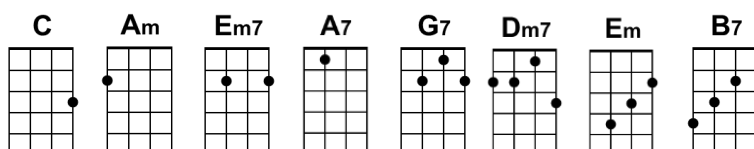
[C] After [Am] I, kinda [Em7] straighten my [Am] tie
