I say [D]/ little ole [A7] wine drinker [D] me [A7]

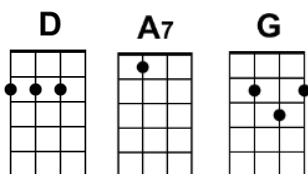
I [D] came here last [G] week from down in [D] Nashville
